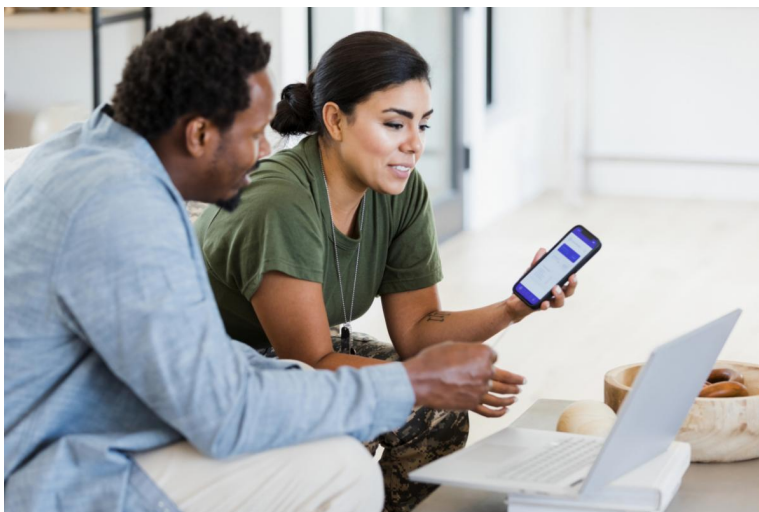

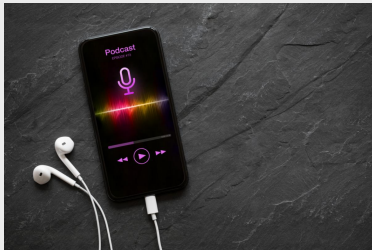
WEBINAR: (Part 2) Digital Inclusion: Targeted Strategies for Reaching Underserved Populations
