Veterans' Program Letters (VPL)

Veterans' Program Letters (VPLs) provide policy guidance about VETS programs to grantees. VPLs transmit: program policy, implementation guidance, procedures, and other information to parties under a grant or contract agreement with VETS.

Grant Officer's Memoranda (GO)

Grant Officer's Memoranda (GO Memo) are policy notices from the Grant Officer to VETS grant recipients. They are used to communicate changes to the Terms and Conditions of the grant to ensure recipients are aware of a critical process change, or in response to an emergent situation that requires some action or change.

Experiencing Homelessness (1 of 2)

- [U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs \(VA\) Supportive Services for Veteran Families \(SSVF\)](#), which provides case management and supportive services to prevent imminent housing loss and rapidly re-houses veterans and their families who are experiencing homelessness
- [VA Housing and Urban Development - Veteran Affairs Supportive Housing \(HUD-VASH\)](#), which is a collaborative program that combines the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) housing vouchers with VA supportive services to permanently house eligible veterans experiencing homelessness and their families

Experiencing Homelessness (2 of 2)

- [VA Grant Per Diem \(GPD\)](#), which offers transitional housing and case management services to veterans experiencing homelessness
- [HUD Continuum of Care \(CoC\) Program](#), which is a coordinated communitywide program that quickly rehouses individuals experiencing homelessness
- [VA Homeless Veterans Community Employment Services \(HVCES\)](#), which is a program that aims to improve employment outcomes for veterans who have experienced homelessness
