  - Annual Income as defined in <u>24 C.F.R.</u> § <u>5.609</u>
  - U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)
     Definition of "At Risk of Homelessness"
- Eligibility and Documentation:

# **NVTAC Technical Assistance (TA) Overview**

## NVTAC Role (1 of 2)



- Provide TA designed to increase grant recipients' ability to establish and operate successful HVRP grants
- Support HVRP grant recipients throughout their period of performance to ensure that challenges are resolved quickly
- Provide effective training and peer-to-peer learning opportunities that result in increased knowledge and adoption of innovative practices among HVRP programs nationwide

## NVTAC Role (2 of 2)



- Provide technical expertise to federal staff to assist in policy development in support of program oversight and strategic planning for the future of HVRP
- Quantify grant recipients' customer satisfaction, and share promising practices and lessons learned

#### **Technical Assistance**



- NVTAC provides individualized one-on-one TA, which is available to all HVRP grant recipients throughout their period of performance
- TA can be requested by the grant recipient or their Grant Officer's Technical Representative (GOTR)
- Grant recipients do not need to be experiencing performance challenges to work with NVTAC
  - Many grant recipients request TA for topics outside of performance challenges (i.e., staff turnover, leadership training, etc.)
- Requests for TA can be sent to <u>contact@nvtac.org</u>
  - > Your organization will be assigned a TA coach upon receipt of your request


## Peer-to-Peer Opportunities
