Key Points

• Introduction

 NVTAC staff introduced the topic and purpose of today's CoP: OTED. NVTAC also introduced the guest presenter, Stacy Valenti, VA OTED.

• Veteran and Spouse Transitional Assistance Grant Program (VSTAGP)

- This new grant program, administered by the VA's OTED department, provides support for veterans and spouses in career advancement, covering all veterans regardless of discharge character.
- The program's funding totals \$5 million, with awards up to \$500,000 per grant recipient. A matching component was included for grant recipients, doubling the program's total investment in its initial year.
- Recipients include government agencies, nonprofits, and educational institutions.
 Thirteen organizations across the U.S. were selected in the first round from 65 applications, with services to begin by January 2, 2025.

• Grant Eligibility and Goals

- Open to all veterans and spouses without restrictions based on service period, theater, or discharge type.
- Focuses on providing living wages rather than solely employment, recognizing the importance of economic stability for family units.
- Services under the grant include resume assistance, interview training, job recruitment, and other career development resources.

• Future of the Program

- The grant is structured as a five-year program, with plans underway to make it a permanent offering.
- There is potential for additional notices of funding in the coming years, with hopes to fill service gaps in underserved areas.
